

STEMTech Amazing Race

Terms and Conditions

To be eligible to enter STEMTech AMAZING RACE, you must agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. The STEMTech Amazing Race promotion will run from Monday February 1st through to May 31st and will be open to all Distributors in all 14 opened countries around the world.
2. Any **Virtual** Distributor may pay for and attend Convention but cannot be part of the Amazing Race promotion.
3. You must be an active Distributor as of January 31st 2010 with a minimum of a one bottle AutoShip order for the entire length of the race, February 1st to May 31st
4. It is highly recommended that you complete specified pre-race challenges in December and January to get momentum and a head start on other racers.
5. You must achieve all weekly challenges (some are hard, some are not) or you will be eliminated from the Grand Prix Presentation.
6. Hint: In addition to other weekly challenges, all personal recruitment will have MPH values assigned to it for the duration of the promotion.
7. If you miss one week's challenge you can CATCH UP QUICK in the subsequent week by completing the challenge you missed as well as the current challenge. You may do this as often as you like during the 18 challenges.
8. If you miss more than 2 consecutive weeks you are eliminated and cannot rejoin the race for the Grand Prix Presentation. However even if you are eliminated from the Grand Prix Presentation, you may still qualify for Convention ticket, airfare and accommodation subsidies.
9. If you do not attend Convention you cannot transfer any prizes or subsidies achieved, to any other distributor.
10. If you achieve a refundable element of the promotion, your payment for that element will be refunded after Convention has been attended.
11. If you do not have a partner and travel alone, but achieve airfare subsidies for 2 persons, you will be awarded a \$500 redemption voucher for the sales room in place of the second subsidy.
12. Airfare subsidies are capped at \$500 each for flights originating in the North America and \$1,000 each for flights originating internationally, and will be refunded after Convention and upon receipt of official flight receipts.
13. Accommodation must be reserved and paid for by the Distributor and, if earned for free in the Amazing Race, will be refunded to their account immediately after Convention upon submission of official hotel receipts. Incidentals such as telephone calls, Internet charges and beverages will not be refunded.
14. Entry into STEMTech Amazing Race is FREE.
15. You will also be given the opportunity to pay the Convention ticket price at a discounted rate in February of \$199.00 USD or choose our payment option plan of 4 equal recurring monthly payments of \$60.00 USD, charged to your specified account in February, March, April and May respectively.

16. Prices for Convention tickets will rise in March to \$229.00USD, in April to \$249.00USD and in May –July to \$279.00USD.
17. If you pay a Convention registration fee and cannot attend, you may request a refund by emailing racecontrol@stemtechhealth.com from the email address of record or by mailing a signed letter to Race Control, STEMTech HealthSciences, 1011 Calle Amanecer, San Clemente, CA 92673, USA. All refund requests MUST be received by MAY 31st 2010 in order to be refunded. After May 31st 2010 Convention tickets will not be refunded, however unused tickets may be applied to a future Convention or transferred to another distributor.
18. Convention fee covers registration, applicable meals and workshops.
19. NOT all workshops will be translated.
20. You must complete the online signup form and agree to these Terms & Conditions before your Amazing Race entry will be accepted.
21. You must complete the free registration/ entry process before January 31st to be eligible to compete for the Grand Prize.
22. All entries received after the 31st January 2010 will be deemed as being Rookies, and will be eligible to compete for Convention subsidies in the Rookie Division of the STEMTech Amazing Race but will not be eligible to compete for the \$10,000 Grand Prize. ONLY ENTRIES RECEIVED BEFORE JANUARY 31ST WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE GRAND PRIX PRESENTATION.
23. All weekly challenges will be based on your PERSONAL efforts, not team efforts, although there maybe some 1st level requirements for leaders.
24. All those who enter the race will have their 'race number' issued sequentially and published on the website, which will be updated weekly with MPH values shown until 100 MPH is reached and then the values will be hidden.
